

Open call for 15 volunteers in France

Join Parcours le Monde Grand-Ouest and make a difference!



- → WHEN? (Date and duration of mobility): 9 months, starting in September/October 2020 or 7 months starting in December 2020
- → WHERE?: Pays de la loire region: in Nantes or Saint-Nazaire or in Angers, France
- → ACCOMODATION: flatsharing (2 or 3 people) (Possibility of housing allowances around 200€/month)
- → **VOLUNTEER ALLOWANCES**: 580,55 €/per month
- → WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR: Someone aged between 18 and 25 years old, who is motivated, curious, dynamic and a willing to take part in the volunteering in Service Civique, which is a french device; Knowing how to speak French is beneficial, but not a requirement.

About the organization:

The association **Parcours le Monde Grand Ouest** has the goal to diffuse (and develop), through formal and informal education, topics related to intercultural dialogue and citizenship by enabling young people to engage in European and international mobilities. Our actions as a **mobility enabler association** include the promotion of empowerment, social link, and professional insertion for young people from 18 to 25 years old or/and to publics with less opportunities.



Parcours Le Monde Grand Ouest is in partnership with local organisations located in Pays de la Loire (France) and offers 15 missions of 9 month for 15 young, curious and motivated people to take part of the volunteering.

<u>Description of the mission « Vivre Ensemble Ici et Ailleurs»</u>

Throughout the duration of the mission, the volunteer will be required to carry out activities for young people from the Loire region in order to encourage civic commitment, openness to others and intercultural dialogue.

The volunteer will be required to:

- co-facilitate education workshops on citizenship and international solidarity,
- Organize various awareness and information times on international mobility for young people (participation in forums, seminars, summer jobs' fairs, etc.);
- to question representations and prejudices,
- organize thematic debates in connection with the SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals),
 worldwide citizenship especially with the especially with the sustainable development
- foreign press review
- Organize and present workshops for groups of young people on the departure or return of an experience of international mobility;
- Participate in the promotion/valuing of the experiences of young people (radio programs, written and video testimonies...);
- Contribute to linguistic and cultural preparation workshops organized by the association;
- Contribute to the content day on social networks and the website;
- Initiate new actions, propose new missions related to the objectives of the program and according to the motivations of each volunteer (project around video, graphics, etc.)









GROUPINGS AND TRAINING

The volunteers will have to carry out several regional groupings to:

- ☐ thematic training to learn the basics and tools of popular education.
- allow many meetings with other volunteers, but also professionals from the area and the volunteering sector.
- 2 days Civic and Citizen training
- PSC1 first aid training
